

EU Cultural Landscape Project Successfully Concluded in Croatia

The international project **EU Cultural Landscape (EU Landscape)**, implemented by **LAG PRIZAG** within the **CERV Programme**, was successfully held from **7 to 9 November 2025** in **Novi Marof and Breznički Hum, Croatia**. The project gathered **251 participants from seven European countries**, focusing on the protection, promotion, and valorisation of cultural landscapes and rural heritage.



The three-day programme included partner presentations, a documentary film screening on the cultural landscape of the LAG PRIZAG area, structured group debates, a guided visit to local heritage sites, and a round table discussion with experts and public representatives. A key project outcome was the **signing of a Cooperation Agreement**, confirming partners' commitment to future collaboration.



Project activities were complemented by cultural events and public participation during the **Prigorsko-Zagorski Autumn Fair**, ensuring strong visibility and engagement with the local community. Project evaluation questionnaires confirmed a high level of partner satisfaction, particularly regarding organization, quality of activities, and opportunities for cooperation.



The **EU Cultural Landscape** project strengthened international partnerships, increased awareness of cultural landscape preservation, and established a solid foundation for future joint EU initiatives focused on sustainable rural development.
